FLIGHT PLAN:

Registration

- 5:40PM Check in and get your boarding pass (name tag and seating assignment)
- 5:45PM Dinner begins promptly in Harper Hall. We will begin with prayer, eat family style, each take our turn at cleaning up our table, and participate in a fun activity that we call "Holy Hilarity".
- 6:30PM Adults will either participate in an Adult Education class, attend an activity with their child, do some mission work around the church, sit and read a good book, meditate, share fellowship with friends, clean up the kitchen... the possibilities are endless. The only requirement is that you don't open the cabin doors while we are in flight and try to jump out off the plane. *(In short, you must stay on site during the time your child is here).* Your flight does last an hour.
- 7:30PM Landing... everyone goes home.

(CHILDCARE will be provided for any child "K" and younger from 6:30 – 7:30 PM in our nursery area.)

Registration is not complete until a parent or a sponsoring adult has filled out a registration form. If you prefer to sign up on a week-by-week basis, sign-ups and associated fees must be made by noon on the Sunday prior to the Wednesday your family intends to participate.

Fees:

Payment of all fees at the time of registration is preferred. However, payment arrangements can be made upon request to pay 50% at the time of registration and the rest of the fee in installments to be completed by November 15.

No family will be denied the rich Christian experience of JOURNEYS for financial reasons. Scholarship aid is available. Please contact Barry Harrison to make arrangements for financial aid. All requests and arrangements are strictly confidential!

The following fees have been set to pay for the JOURNEYS Program. Fees are paid per semester (September and January... each for a 10 week period).

The 2011-2012 Program Enrollment fees per semester are:

\$40 per person

\$5 per person per meal if you choose to sign-up for only a portion of the 10 "trips" (no cap).

Tuition is capped at \$160.00 for a family

These fees cover the cost of weekly meals for the families and other incidental expenses necessary to support the program.

A NOTE ABOUT AFTER DINNER ACTIVITIES

Children in grades 1-6 will have the chance to participate in a Bible Skills class or special activity. Most of the after dinner activities with the exception of the Bible Skills classes are open to only those children in grades 4-6 and require parent participation in the activity with the child.

A NOTE ABOUT DINNER TIME

During the dinner time, a unique sense of church family develops as families share a meal every week. The meal is served family style giving everyone the opportunity to serve one another. We grow as a congregational "family" as table members share important events in their lives, enjoy a meal, and experience the "holy-hilarity" brought about by after dinner activities. This year, those kids currently in grades 7 or higher may choose to sit together as a group instead of with their families.
