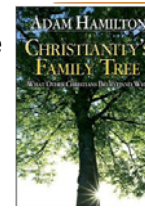

The purpose of the course is to help us
gain an appreciation for the richness of various
Christian traditions, give us a better
understanding of church history, and enrich our
own faith experiences by exploring faith and
practices within the Christian family. Hamilton
invites ministers from each faith to add relevant
perspectives about their faith and practices.

Reverend Adam Hamilton is a Methodist
minister, serving the United Methodist Church
of the Resurrection. He is the presenter of the
DVD course. Topics include Orthodoxy,
Catholicism, Lutheranism, Presbyterianism,
Anglicanism, Baptists, and Methodism.

There is an accompanying book that will be
made available for those with a desire to
expand their knowledge beyond the class study
time; it is not mandatory to purchase the book.

The course is 10 weeks and uses DVDs to
present their information.
